Our Mission: To provide hope, education, and support to anyone affected by Sarcoma in the Pacific Northwest while investing in research to improve cure rates for Sarcomas.






Improved Volunteer Committees

Finishing the last of our Murdock grant awarded in 2021, we have finished developing our donor relationship management system to better communicate, track, and support our donors.






Furthered our Corporate Partner Relationships
