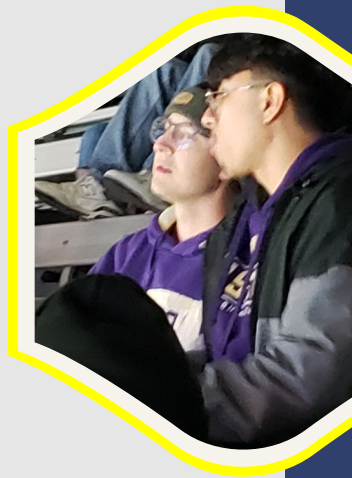

Encouraged Program Growth

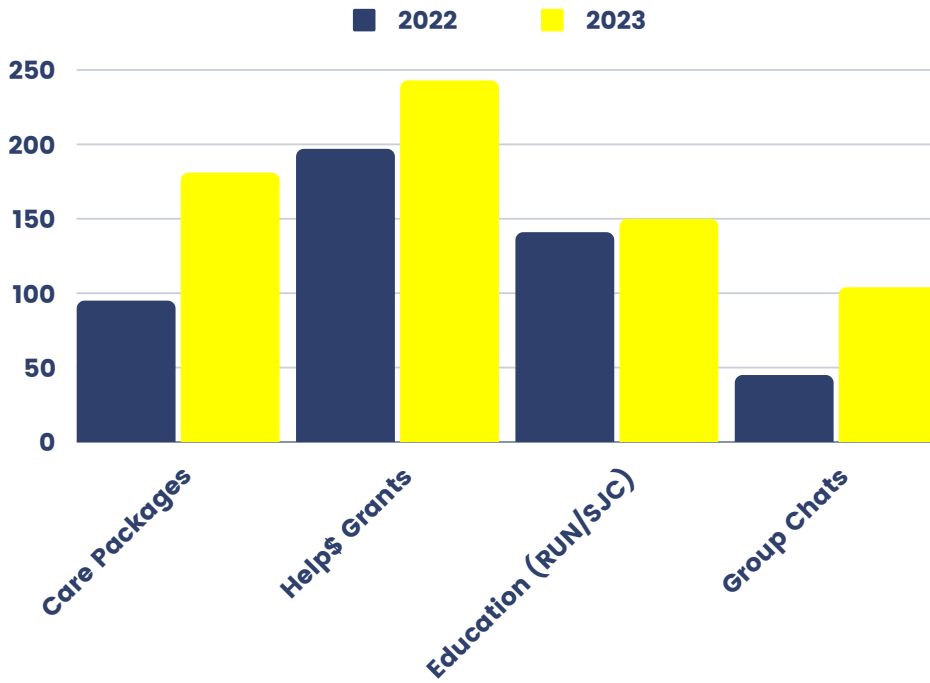

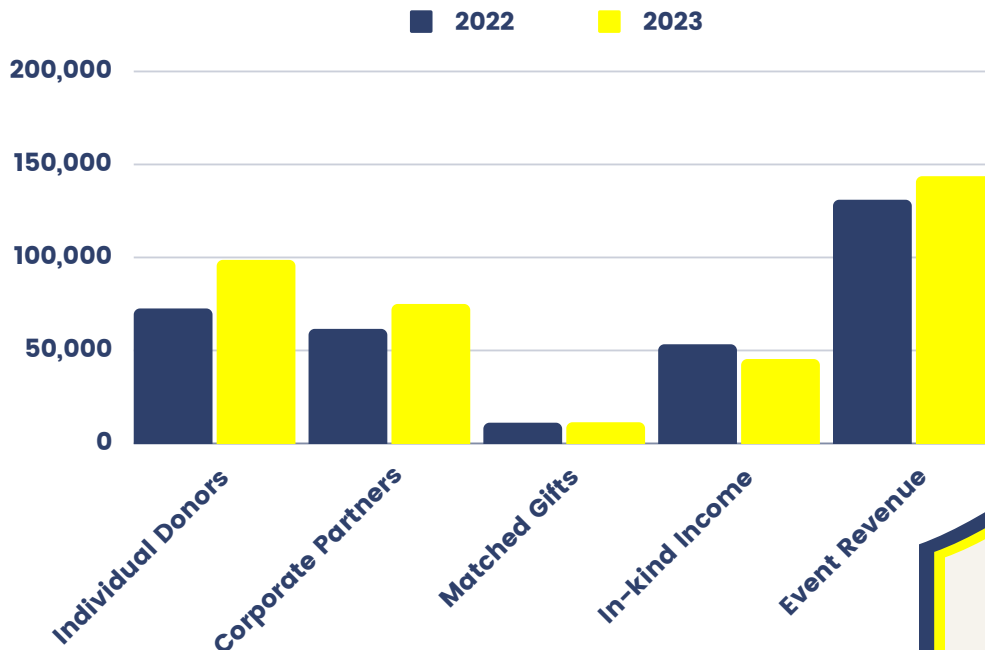
