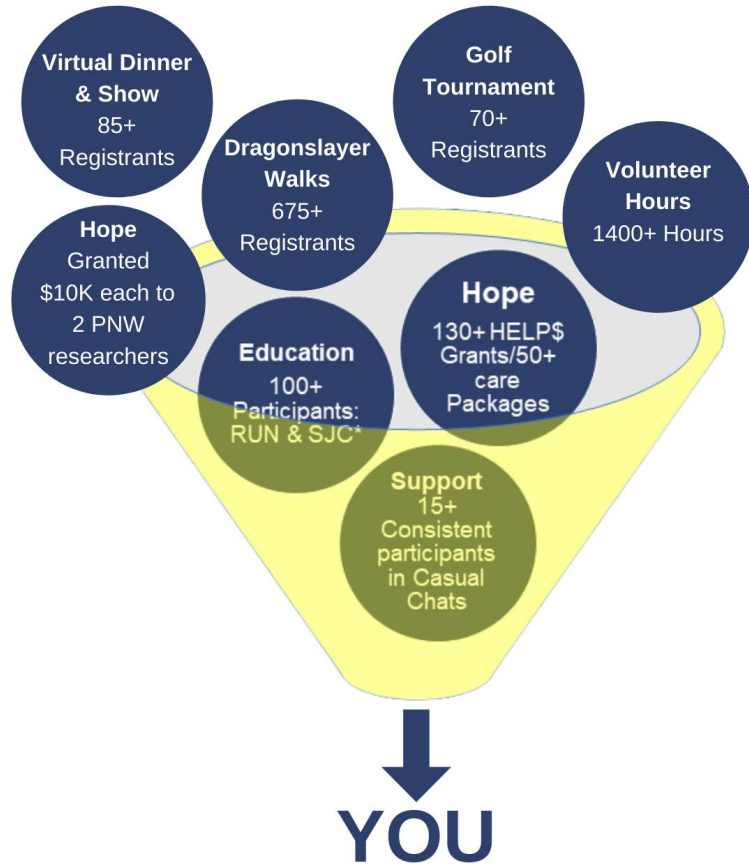

Research
Since 2011, NWSF has invested more than \$325,000 in Sarcoma specific research.

Patient Grants
\$500 provides a grant for transportation, household or medical expenses. In 2021, over \$65K has been provided to patients.

Care Packages
\$50 helps mail multiple packages to support patients and survivors of Sarcoma angels aiding in comfort during treatments or after the loss of a loved one.

Sarcoma Journal Club
\$2,000 a year helps hosts three Sarcoma Journal Club meetings for physicians across PNW to discuss the latest research.
