Help us continue to create a community of hope, education, and support through your future planned giving. Consider including a gift to the Northwest Sarcoma Foundation in your will, living trust, as a beneficiary of a life insurance policy, estate plan or retirement assets.

We are pleased to work with you on donations to the NWSF through your will or trust. While some information is provided below, we recommend that you consult with your attorney about this giving option.

You can express your commitment to the NWSF through your estate planning, by making a bequest to benefit NWSF. Bequests are revocable and can be easily created by including one of the following paragraphs, or similar language recommended by your estate planning attorney, within your Last Will and Testament.

You can place one of the following statements in your will to indicate your intention to support the NWSF:

Specific Bequest

“I give to the Northwest Sarcoma Foundation the sum of \$_____ (OR all my right, title and interest in the following described property) to be used in such manner as the Board of Directors of The Goodtimes Project shall, in its sole discretion, determine.”

Residuary Bequest

“I give to the Northwest Sarcoma Foundation the residue of my estate to be used in such manner as the Board of Directors of the Northwest Sarcoma Foundation shall, in its sole discretion, determine.”

Proportional Bequest

“I give to the Northwest Sarcoma Foundation (a stated percentage or a fraction of the residue of my estate) to be used in such manner as the Board of Directors of the Northwest Sarcoma Foundation shall, in its sole discretion, determine.”

Contingent Bequest

“In the event that _____ (name of spouse, child, sibling, etc.) shall not survive me, then I give the same to the Northwest Sarcoma Foundation to be used in such manner as the Board of Directors of the Northwest Sarcoma Foundation shall, in its sole discretion, determine.”
